EVICTION MORATORIUM

The CDC eviction moratorium ended in September 2021. This means that residents could face eviction, as the tenant handbook outlines, for nonpayment of rent, maintenance charges or fees. It does not relieve any individual of any obligation to pay rent, make a housing payment, or comply with any other obligation that the individual may have under a tenancy, lease, or similar contract. Beginning October 1, 2021, all outstanding balances must be paid in full that are under \$1,000, or for those over \$1,000, a repayment agreement must be in place. Late fees will resume as outlined in

the tenant handbook.



COVID-19 INFORMATION AND UPDATES



For the safety of everyone, please wear your mask and follow social distancing guidelines of 6 feet whenever entering FCHA's foyer or attending FCHA events. Please follow these guidelines when FCHA personnel or inspector enter your home.

COVID numbers are on the rise again in our community. Since July, the number of COVID-19 patients at WellSpan hospitals has quadrupled. If you haven't already been vaccinated, it's not too late to give yourself, and those you come in contact with, the protection of a vaccine. While no vaccine is 100% effective, being vaccinated greatly reduces your chances of contracting COVID-19 as well as serious illness if you would get sick. According to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, up to 90% of those admitted to hospitals with COVID are unvaccinated. Vaccine appointments for those 12 and older can be scheduled. You may have a sore arm, headache, fever or chills after receiving the vaccine.




Continue to wear a mask wash your hands, and maintain your distance.
